We help people with disabilities and seniors to do the things they want to do at home and work.



We also help children at school and play time.

We help in 2 ways:



1. Our volunteers make things like special equipment or things to help you get around, as well as other things to help people to do what they want. Sometimes we change equipment to make it work better.



2. We make special bikes which we call Freedom Wheels. The bikes have special parts so children who cannot walk can ride a bike.

Our therapist and volunteers will visit you before they start making your equipment.



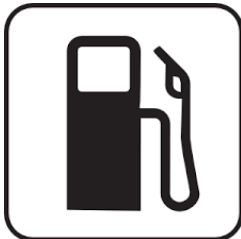
When we have finished helping you, we will check to make sure you are happy with what we have made for you.
