How you can continue to support Solve Disability Solutions in your Will

Simply by nominating your bequest to us now will cost you nothing, but the work that gift will allow us to do later, when your Estate is distributed, will ensure that your concern lives on.

Should you die without having made a Will, your Estate will be distributed in ways you might not approve of and by people you may not even know. It is therefore essential that you decide where your property will go and in what proportions and who should be appointed your Executor.

If you have already made your Will, be sure that it is up-to-date and suited to your present wishes. If you wish to make any changes, you have the choice of adding a Codicil to it, or alternatively writing a new Will.

Be careful not to write your wishes in letter form or in any way that is not legally valid. A Will must be drawn up and signed on every page by the Testator and two witnesses, neither of whom is permitted to be a beneficiary under the terms of the Will.

Best of all, seek the advice of a Solicitor or Trust Company. These will ensure that your wishes are properly fulfilled and that the legality of the Will cannot be challenged.

Nominating your gift to Solve Disability Solutions is very simple

You can nominate Solve Disability Solutions as a primary beneficiary in your Will or to share in your residuary Estate, directing that your gift is for “the general purposes of Solve Disability Solutions Inc..”

We suggest the following wording in your Will;

“I leave to Solve Disability Solutions Inc., C/ Royal Talbot Rehabilitation Centre, 1 Yarra Boulevard, Kew 3101, for its general purposes.....

(here insert the sum of money, portion of Estate or description of property) for receipt of its Treasurer or other proper officer shall be sufficient discharge to my Executors”.

Almost one-third of all Australians die without having made a will. This means that their affairs must be handled by a court-appointed administrator—not as they would have wished but according to the laws of the state.

Please write, or up-date your Will as soon as you can, and thank you for remembering those we help and support.

Before you make your Will these hints may be helpful:

- Sit down quietly with a piece of paper and start by listing the people and organisations you would like to benefit from your Will.
- List all your possessions and property (and debts).
- Decide how you would like to divide your possessions amongst the people and organisations you have listed.
- Take this information to your Solicitor or Legal Adviser.
- If you would like to have funeral guests make memorial donations to Solve Disability Solutions in lieu of flowers, discuss this with your family or the relevant people beforehand. We can provide leaflets to assist with this if required.
