How Solve works

Solve Disability Solutions improves the quality of life of people with disabilities and those assisting them, by increasing independence and providing opportunity to pursue their goals at home, school, work and at leisure.

Solve works with people with disabilities to custom build equipment to enhance independence and participation in the following key areas:

Solve combines the skills of Occupational Therapists and technical volunteers to solve equipment problems by modifying or custom building equipment to suit individual requirements.

Freedom Wheels Modified Bike program: We modify bikes for children and adults to enable participation in cycling activities. The program is overseen by a therapist who works with volunteers to assess and then customise bikes to suit individual needs.

Custom Equipment: Each request is assessed and coordinated by an Occupational Therapist who, with a volunteer, visits the person with a disability at the place where the equipment is to be used. Solve takes a person centred approach; together ideas are discussed and custom modifications and designs are built to meet the person's specific needs.
